Philly to do full payroll audit of Amtrak employees to find city wage tax scofflaws

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Officials in Philadelphia plan a payroll audit of all Amtrak employees assigned to the 30th Street Station office after finding two employees who have not been paying the city's wage tax.

City Controller Alan Butkovitz says the two employees live outside the city but have not paid city worker wage taxes totaling about \$9,000 for the last two years. He says the employees had claimed an exemption to which they were not entitled.

Butkovitz says Amtrak has not cooperated with the investigation. He says a preliminary analysis indicates a substantial number may be falsely claiming a wage tax exemption.

In a written statement, Amtrak says it has requested a delay until 2010 but hasn't received a written response. The statement says Amtrak is willing to assist in the audit.
